Math and Reading Focus

math

Students will be assigned math homework on Tuesday and Thursday nights for thirty minutes. This will be work that students should know how to do. If they are unable to answer a question, please circle it, and I am happy to answer questions in class. A student's math goal is determined by their STAR math score. Averaging the Accelerated math with Daily Math work determines math grades. The Accelerated Math grades that go with Daily Math include: Common Core EnVision Math, supplemental sources through Singapore Math, Am practice, review, goals and tests. To earn a grade that reflects the student's learning, effort, and potential, the student must reach their math goals and make good grades on their daily work.





Reading

Students will be assigned reading, for a minimum of thirty minutes, on Tuesday and Thursday nights. A student's reading goal is determined by AimsWeb and Map scores. At the middle of the trimester, they must be 50% or higher and at 100% at the end. Anything below is not supporting the student's learning. Accelerated Reading, novel studies, and the Houghton Mifflin Series will be averaged to determine the student's grade in Reading. The Accelerated Reading grades include: goals, comprehension, and quizzes. To earn a grade that reflects the student's learning, effort, and potential, the students must reach their reading goals and do their Reading work.
